Young Toronto Filmmakers Make the Top Fifteen in CineCoup's Competition to Win a One Million Dollar Film Budget & Release in Cineplex Theaters

Toronto, Canada – On Wednesday May 1, 2013 at 9:30 p.m. CineCoup's Film Accelerator competition announced the fifteen teams who had garnered the most online support. A group of three young indie filmmakers from Toronto are among the teams moving forward in the contest with the trailer for their film Post-Apocalyptica.

Next for the team is preparing their package for pre-sale pitching at Cannes, running a crowd funding campaign, and for the Top Five teams a trip to the Banff World Media Festival where the winner will be decided.

Post-Apocalyptica is a raw character piece that looks at the resilience of human nature and how much we can adapt in order to survive. It moves effortlessly between the harsh realities of a dangerous and unforgiving world, and the small joys of life that make the struggle worthwhile.
