THE HOOK

By flipping the universally familiar concept of Alien Abductions on its ear we've created a story already familiar to viewers but with a twist we've never seen. Alien Abduction relates and attaches its central theme to audiences everywhere by simply having them ask themselves "What if it was me?" With the already significant reach of our cast and crew into the Sci-Fi, Cartoon and Pop-Culture communities, along with the vast, global UFO and Paranormal community, we believe our film reaches audiences far beyond just film with a strong, positive message about the world we live in.

THE FILM MAKERS

In 1999, Matt Granger's career began as videographer on Bryan Singer's "X-Men" which led to the creation of the "X-Men 1.5 DVD" & the opportunity to be mentored by director Alex Proyas (*The Crow*), screenwriter David Hayter (*Watchmen*), producer Don Murphy (*Natural Born Killers*), & Oscar winning actor Russell Crowe. Matt partnered with his brother Mikey to form "The Granger Bros" and for over a decade they've been creating their unique brand of films including "Epic" which featured rare comedy performances by Robert Patrick & Harrison Ford, as well as numerous shorts licensed by Lionsgate for use in the film "Good Luck Chuck".

In 2009, director Quentin Tarantino chose the Granger Bros' Pulp Fiction spoof "Quarter Pounder with Cheese" as the winner of MTV's Bastardize Tarantino contest. The brothers then raised over \$10,000 in one of Indie-GoGo's earliest crowd funding successes for "The Charlie Da Clown Show" which can be seen on Will Farrell's "Funny or Die" site along with their follow-up "Crazy Dracula Spring Break Weekend." The brothers' produced/co-written horror short "Chained" was an Official Selection of Screamfest 2011 and screened at the legendary Grauman's Chinese Theatre in Hollywood. Soon after, the short received the Rincon International Film Festival 2012 Award of Excellence and has been an Official Selection in numerous festivals around the world. "Chained" has now been adapted into a feature screenplay.

In addition to their work in film, the brothers were the co-creators and organizers of "The Summer 2012 – 519 Punk Festival" an outdoor music festival, featuring 11 punk/metal bands headlined by "The Asexuals" feat. John Kastner of the Doughboys, a reunited "Teenage Head" and metal legends "GWAR". The show was a great success and raised several thousand dollars for numerous charities. Raised in Los Angeles, Kaleena Kiff enjoyed a successful career as an actress before moving behind the camera in 2005. Since the award-winning short film *When Jesse Was Born*, she has produced at least one film per year. As a director, Kaleena's debut short *Alice & Huck* earned multiple international awards. In 2009, she co-created the critically acclaimed webseries *Riese: Kingdom Falling*, which was acquired by Syfy and licensed worldwide to NBC/Universal and novelized by Simon & Schuster. Kaleena directed the first five episodes of *Riese* and executive produced the series. As a producer, Kaleena's feature film *Marilyn* debuted in December 2011 at the Whistler Film Festival where it was nominated for Best Canadian Feature and received eight Leo Award nominations, including Best Picture. The film's star, Ryan Robbins, took home the Best Actor Leo for his performance in *Marilyn*. Kaleena is developing web and television projects with BBC Worldwide, MSN, Muse Entertainment and Content Media. With her company Trinity Works Ent, Kaleena is developing a feature film starring Robert Carlyle (*Trainspotting*) which will go to camera in 2014 in Scotland. Kaleena is also co-owner of the post-production company FrameRate Creative Services. Kaleena recently completed post on the thriller *Death Do Us Part*, which she produced and 2nd Unit directed.
