Genre: Drama, Thriller, Political Satire

Logline: At a time when the government's decision could strip a third of the populace of their basic rights and freedoms, one unsuspecting Clown's journey lands him in a lynchpin position where his decisions could be the spark that ignites a worldwide fire.

Synopsis: War Paint is set in an alternate reality wherein people all over the world are "born" as clowns. These people face universal hate and subjugation for no other reason than being different.

Unable to hold down a job and struggling to find his place in the world, Corky the Clown only finds happiness in the company of his best friend and mentor Chuckles and his young neighbor Katya. That all changes however, when fate collides him with Valentine, the charismatic yet deadly leader of the violent clown activist group the Big Shoes Brigade. An unfortunate misdeed leaves Corky with no choice but to go underground and hide under Valentines protection.

Frustrated and faced with a radical new viewpoint, Corky is swept up in the cause of the BSB. His actions land him on the radar of Carlson, the federal agent tracking their activities. Due to a rise in anti-clown sentiment a bill has reached the senate floor that if passed would prohibit clowns from wearing their paint in public or the workplace.

John "Patches" O'Toole, the only clown senator, long time proponent for clown rights appeals to his fellow senators to vote no on this bill as it is an infringement of basic civil liberties. But because of the increasingly violent demonstrations of the BSB his plight is falling on deaf ears. Tensions mount as clowns everywhere unite in outrage and Corky must decide whether to fight alongside his own kind, or do what he can to prevent the world from falling apart.
